Chinese Association of Animal science and Veterinary medicine (CAAV) will host the 3rd China Swine Science and technology Conference (CSSC2019) in 19th-21st Sept. 2019, together with the Annual Conference of CAAV in Qingdao, China. This biennial conference will focus on swine industry, and brings all relevant subjects associating with swine science on this platform, like Nutrition and feed, genetic breeding, farming and equipment, veterinary and medicine, farm waste disposal and environment protection, meat processing, and industrial economic research. The conference will set up plenary conference and parallel subject forums in two and half days. It is estimated that total 2,500 participates will attend, including professors, researchers, students, farmers and other industrial people from China and foreign countries. The theme of CSSC is set up as Ecology, Quality and Efficiency.

In 19th -21st Sept. 2019, CAAV will organize Swine Science and Innovation Exposition co-located with CSSC. It will be the first time of exclusive Expo to Swine Science and Innovation in China, and it open to registry of local and international exhibitors.

China is the biggest pork production and consumption country in the world. The output of pork in 2017 was reported as 53.4 million tons, shared more than 50% of world total. It stopped 2

consecutive years of reduction since 2015. The per capita consumption of pork was 41kg/person/year, which is listed in top 5 in the world.
